## **Objective 1: Sustainable Houses**

#	Action	Resourcing	Timeline
1.1	Improve the energy efficiency of the site through installing solar panels and upgrading our electric hot water to heat pump technology	Additional resourcing required	3-5 years
1.2.	Build up our community composting capability	Within existing resources	1 year



## **Objective 2: Resilient Houses**

#	Action	Resourcing	Timeline
2.1	Improve the thermal comfort of the building (eg. draught proofing, insulation, double glazing of windows)	Additional resourcing required	3-5 years
2.2	Increase habitat for native bees and insects on site (support biodiversity)	Within existing resources	1 year
